The campaign is in conjunction with a sustainability group that is facilitating the purchase of freehold properties adjoining National Parkland that may otherwise be cleared. They are then managed by the local Kuku Yalanji indigenous people, giving them back access to their land and employment.

In 2016 the Uniting Church began a campaign to advocate for more compassionate and effective drug laws and policies.
